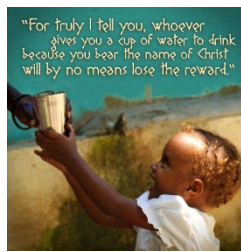

October 6, following 11:00 am Mass at St. Joseph Parish (392 Palace Road, Kingston). We will gather at the southwest corner of the church for a prayer. We will proceed to the edge of St. Joseph's parking lot facing Sir John A MacDonald Blvd led by our Canadian Flag, followed by St. Joseph's CWL and K of C banners.
