Welcome and call meeting to order (Kelly Neville)

2. Spiritual Advisor's Report (Father Americo)

Father outlined Liturgical Celebrations and plans for the Advent and Christmas seasons

- Advent: The first Sunday in Advent is December 3rd. There will be Confessions from 4:00 pm on Sunday, Dec 3rd. Fathers Grainger and Sebastion Amato will assist Father Americo. In the morning of December 3rd Confessions will be heard following Mass at St. Linus
- Christmas: December 24th morning 4th Sunday of Advent. Christmas Eve: 5:15pm at Blessed Sacrament; 7:00 pm at St. Linus and 9:00pm at Blessed Sacrament. December 25th 10:00 am Mass at Blessed Sacrament
- New Years Eve/New Years Day: Mass at 5:15pm for New Years Eve; January 1st 2024; 10:00 am at Blessed Sacrament
- **December 8**th: Mass at the Cathedral at 10:30 am.

Business Arising from the Last Meeting:

10. Snowflake Bazaar: (Kelly Neville)

- Volunteers for the Tea Room: included are several grandchildren who will assist CWL members with serving in the tea room
- Liz Ford stated that she will look after Children's Activities. Anne Nicholls grandchild will assist her.
- Shirley and Gord McDonald had already decorated the hall for the bazaar. Further set up for the bazaar will be Friday, November 17th.

11. Hall Cleaning/ Pie Making: (Margaret Wilson for Cathy Splinter)

- On November 9th Cathy Splinter, Anne Nicholls, and Teresa smith cleaned the kitchen while men from the Knights of Columbus looked after cleaning the floors
- A total of 133 pies were made with 16 ladies assisting in their preparation on November 10th. Margaret asked that members donating for the bake sale consider adding donations to the tea room.

12. Helen Henderson Birthday Party: (Kelly Neville)

• Four members of the CWL donated a total of 48 cupcakes on the 19th of October. Kelly was the only CWL member present. Staff again commented that we were the first community group to host a birthday party since Covid.

13. Helen Henderson Care Centre: (Donna Guiney)

• Father is looking for more volunteers on Sundays for Liturgy of the Word at the Centre. Gail Raymond is already volunteering at the Windsor assisting Father Grainger (a resident there). Gail reported that Briargate hopes to offer Liturgy of the Word in December and volunteers are needed there as well. Paul Godfrey used to assist at Briargate prior to COVID.

New Business:

15. Elections: Donna Guiney

- Committee received 24 nominations for various positions. Kelly Neville, Theresa Shanks, Mary Lou Hills
 and Donna Guiney each called 6 of the nominees. The results were disappointing: Shirley McDonald
 agreed to stand for the Vice Presidency. Under the new organizational structure the Vice President is
 responsible for membership renewal, recruitment so she will continue to look after membership.
- Danna Dobson agreed to return as Treasurer as no one else was willing to take on the Treasurer's role.
 Danna also agreed to be the Service Committee chair.
- Kelly Neville assumes the position of Past President

- After consulting with a member of the Diocesan Council, Donna Guiney (Donna, as chair of the Elections Committee under our policy could not let her name be submitted as a nominee) was able to submit her name and would stand as President
- Liz Ford also stepped up on the 14th to assume the chair of the Faith Committee.
- Again, even though Mary Lou Hills also on the Executive of the Diocesan Council, (and as such cannot be
 on another CWL executive) Mary Lou agreed to remain as Secretary until June 2024. This will depend on
 whether she can find another member to mentor and/or the results of the Diocesan elections next April.
 No one stepped forward to assume the position of Secretary.

16. Christmas Pageant: (Donna Guiney)

The Parish hopes to have the Childrens Christmas Pageant during the 5:15 Mass on Christmas Eve. The costumes are ready/ clean. The Children's Liturgy committee hopes to have 2 Sundays for the children to practice. We are looking for a coordinator.

17. Confirmation: (Donna Guiney)

The sacrament of Confirmation will be given to 15 children on Wednesday, December 13 at 700 pm. Their will be a reception in the church hall. Danna Dobson and Mary Lou Hills looked after it last year and are willing to do so again. If necessary, cookies will be ordered from Sydenham Street Bakery. Mary Lou has used them in the past for cakes celebrating parish anniversaries and CWL functions as well as cookies for the reception last year. We will wait to see what cookies/treats may be left over from the bake sale/tea room per the bazaar.

18. Pot Luck Supper: (Kelly Neville)

Since it is difficult to keep food hot if we have the supper after Mass it was suggested that Mass for CWL intentions be said on Tuesday morning. Dinner will begin at 5:30.
